







- He is Michael. He is my brother.

Pronoun + Be



The verb "be" is equivalent to two different verbs in Spanish: "ser" and "estar".



Example 1:

I am from Canada / Soy de Canadá.

Example 2:

I am in Canada / Estoy en Canadá.

Simple present with He, she and it.

RULES

→ In the simple present tense, the verb in 3rd person singular has an S.

Gets Eats Takes

→ Add – "es" when the verb end in (s, o, sh, ch, X or z.)

Go<u>es</u> Watch<u>es</u> Brushes

→ Verbs that en in "y" preceded by a consonant remove the "y" and add les.
