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# Personal Pronouns

A pronoun is a Word that replaces a noun.



Personal pronouns to specific people or things.

Some personal pronouns perform the action.	Some personal pronouns receive the action.
<b>Subject pronouns</b>	<b>Object pronouns</b>
<b>I HE SHE IT YOU SHE THEY</b>	<b>ME HIM THEM US HER</b>
Example: She gave the gift to me.	Example: I thanked her for the gift?

	<u>Singular</u>	<u>Plural</u>
1st. person	I	we
2nd person	You	You
3rd person	He, she, it	They

## Examples:

- He is Michael. He is my brother.
- He is a boy and I am Lucy.
- They are my friends, they are soccer Players and they are happy today.

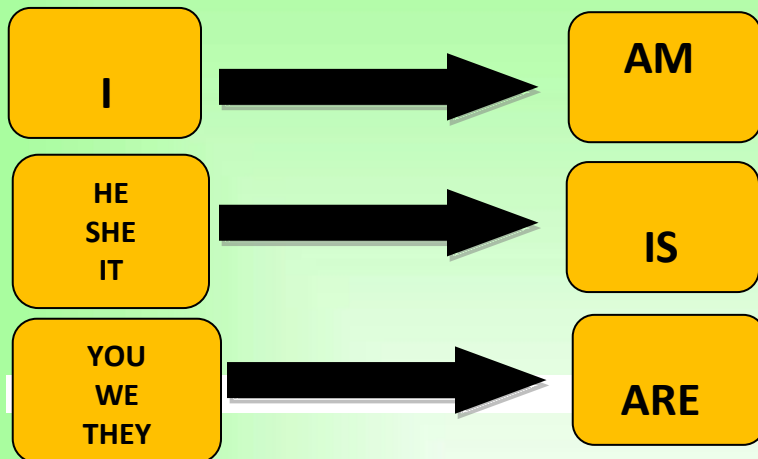




# Pronoun + Be



The verb "be" is equivalent to two different verbs in Spanish: "ser" and "estar".



Pronoun	Be	Contraction
I	am	I'm
You	are	You're
We	are	We're
They	are	They're
He	is	He's
She	is	She's
It	is	It's

## Example 1:

I am from Canada / Soy de Canadá.

## Example 2:

I am in Canada / Estoy en Canadá.

**Contractions are often used when we speak:**

Affirmative Statements		Negative Statements		Interrogative Statements
I am	I'm	I am not	I'm not	Am I ?
You are	You're	You are not	You're not	Are you ?
He is	He's	He is not	He's not	Is he?
She is	She's	She is not	She's not	Is she?
It is	It's	It is not	It's not	Is it?
We are	We're	We are not	We're not	Are we?
They are	They're	They are not	They're not	Are they?

### EXAMPLE:



We're not babies.



I'm a girl.



They're not tall.



He's happy.

## Be: Yes / No Questions

	Question	Answer +	Answer -
Singular	Am I ...?	Yes, You are	No You aren't
	Are You...?	Yes I am	No I 'm not
	Is he / she / it...?	Yes, he/ she / it is	No he / she / it isn't
Plural	Are we / you / they...?	Yes, you / we / they are	No you / we / they aren't

To make yes / no questions, put the be verb before the subject. Do not use the contraction to answer yes to a question. Yes we are.

They are bricklayers. He is a carpenter. She is a teacher. He is a report.

**Examples:**

Is john a doctor? Yes, he is. Is he young? No he isn't.



Is Cecilia a lawyer? No she isn't. She is a teacher.  
Is she a good teacher? Yes she is.  
Are Sammy and Richard bricklayers? Yes, they are  
Are they brothers? No they aren't. They are Friends.

## Present Simple with I, you, we they

Pronoun	Verb	Complement
I	Get up	at 6:00 am.
You	Take a shower	In the morning.
They	sleep	Late.
We	Watch	Tv. In the house.



I ride the bike.



You jump rope.



They kick the ball.

## Simple present with He, she and it.

### RULES

- In the simple present tense, the verb in 3<sup>rd</sup> person singular has an S.

Gets

Eats

Takes

- Add – “es” when the verb end in (s, o, sh, ch, X or z.)

Goes

Watches

Brushes

- Verbs that en in “y” preceded by a consonant remove the “y” and add les.

Studies

Cries

Tries

a vowel precedes the final y just add

**With I, You, We and They.**

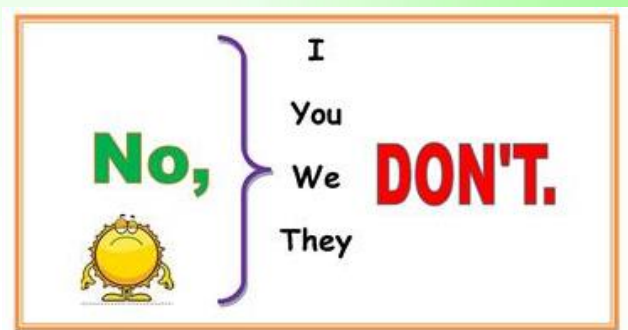
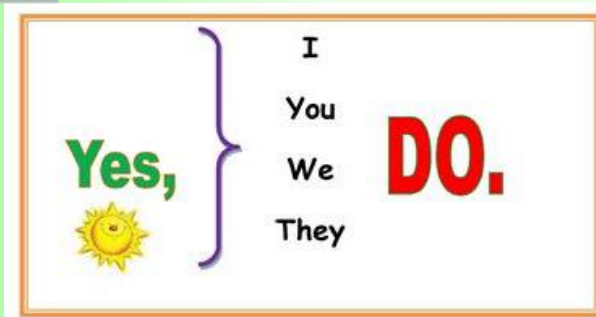


Do	subject	verb	Complement?

Do	We	Watch	television in the evening?
Do	They	Go	to bed at ten o'clock?

**Answer:**

Yes I do.

No I don't.



**With He, She, and It.**



Does	subject	verb	Complement?
Does	He	Get	Up at seven o'clock?
Does	She	Have	dinner at seven?
Dos	It	Watch	television in the evening?

**Answer:**

Yes, He does.

No, He doesn't.





# Present Continuous

The present continuous tense is used for actions happening right now.

Structure:

<u>Subject</u> (I, you he she it we they)	<u>To be</u> (am, are, is)	<u>Main verb + ing</u>
I	Am	Sleeping.

	Affirmative			Negative	
I	am		I	am not	
You/we/they	are	sleeping.	You/we/they	aren't	sleeping.
He/she/ it	is		He/she/it	isn't	

**Example:**



They are running.



She is reading a book.



He isn't sleeping.

## Present Continuous: Spelling Rules of verb – ing

Rules: Add ing to most verbs.

Say → Saying.

Go → Going.

Walk → Walking

If a verb ends in a vowel + consonant +e, remove e and add – ing.

Come → Coming

Make → Making

Live → Living

If a verb ends in a vowel + consonant double the consonant and add – ing.

Swim → Swimming

Clap → Clapping

Get → Getting
